Enclosed you will find information about the President Obama Scholarship Program. Each tribal college is responsible for the processing and selection of one outstanding student to receive a \$3,500 scholarship to be disbursed this fall semester. You may select your student through an application process using the student profile form included or by staff and faculty nomination.

The student will receive a \$3,500.00 scholarship check made co-payable to the student and your institution.

Once your school has selected a student to receive the President Obama Scholarship, the student's information and photo (required) must be **received** at the American Indian College Fund by **November 10, 2010**. You may scan and email the documents to dreed@collegefund.org or fax them to 303-479-9150 or send them via U.S. Mail to American Indian College Fund, 8333 Greenwood Blvd. Denver, CO 80221.

Once we receive application materials of the student selected to receive the President Obama Scholarship, we will notify the student with an official award letter sent to their home address and send a check to the Financial Aid Office on behalf of the student for the fall semester.
